Important Information for Chalk Artists *(please read)*

- All artists must be registered to chalk.
- Check in by 9:30am on Saturday October 12, 2019.
- Art square spaces will be assigned prior to the event.
- **Must use all of the assigned space, including the background of your square section.**
- **Please keep your area clean and your supplies well contained in your space, volunteers will assist you with this.**
- Pastel Chalk will be provided for you and additional chalk will be available at the artist area as well.
- If you need additional colors, you may share or exchange chalk with other artists.
- Only CHALK can be used for drawings. No paint, crayon, ink or other non-washable or permanent products.
- Chalk Art Festival Volunteers will be around to assist you. DO NOT hesitate to ask for chalk, water, etc.
- No fixatives may be used on the chalk drawings.
- Chalk art only to be produced in designated and assigned areas.
- The art created must be suitable for public and family viewing (no nude or lewd work). No words or symbols intended as political statements may appear within the art.
- The event reserves the right to refuse, stop or eliminate objectionable material. If artists have questions about their art, it is recommended that they produce a paper copy of their art for approval prior to the event.
- Please respect the other artists who are working near you. Do not walk on their paintings or have open beverage containers which could spill and damage someone's artwork.
- The event will go on rain or shine. The artists are responsible for protecting their chalk art. Plastic tarps and tape will be available.
- The event will use photographs and video to record the event, artist designs and artists.

General Event Information

- **NEW FOR 2019:** The 2019 Festival will benefit Our Lady of the Hills High School.
- There will be food vendors on site and several restaurants in downtown area that are within walking distance.
- Found items that are turned in will be secured at the Volunteer Tent. Please check there if you have a lost item.
- Portable toilets will be located onsite.
- Artist parking is located in the City Parking Garage next door to Peterson Plaza at 201 Clay Street Kerrville, TX 78028. There is also an ADA parking drop zone near the main Festival entrance. Please let Katharine know if you need to utilize this drop-off zone.
- Cash machines are within a short walking distance throughout the downtown Kerrville area.
- Smoking is not permitted inside any structure or in any seating area on the Festival grounds.

In Case of Rain - Event will go on Rain or Shine!

It is recommended that artists cover their drawings with clear plastic in the event of light rain. It will be the responsibility of the artists to cover their own drawings with the sheets and weigh it down. Only in case of severe weather, the Festival may be cancelled. We will have tarps and tape for you at the artist check-in area.
